The track is the centerpiece of this event, and is built to scouting specifications, so it can be rented to organizations for use at any official scouting events. It even has an electronic finish line to settle all arguments.

It immediately became apparent that this event should include food [of course] and the club provides funding to make that happen, plus the potluck lets everyone share a favorite dish. It's a great way to get out in the garage, shop or basement during the cold season to prepare, and even better to spend an early March Saturday trekking to Medina for some fun.
